

****NEW IMMUNIZATION****
****INFORMATION****

Beginning in the school year 2011/2012 new Pennsylvania Immunization Law requires students in ALL grades have the following immunization in order to attend school:

- 2 dose varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or history of disease and

Children entering 7th grade must have:

- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)
(If 5 years has elapsed since last tetanus immunization)
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

Please check with your doctor to see if your child has had these vaccines and if not please make arrangements for the above vaccines to be obtained.

Please forward proof of vaccines to the school nurse by May 31, 2011.

Proof of vaccine must be on physician or department of health letterhead.

Please be advised that students without a second varicella vaccine will be placed on provisional enrollment.

*****Parents of students entering 7th grade beginning 2011/12 school year are advised that without the above listed vaccines required for 7th grade your child will be placed on provisional enrollment.**
