We have donated our time, books, bookshelves, and a new computer system to update their operation as well as pay the annual subscription fee to stay connected to the local public library system.

We send sophomore students from Lackawanna Trail High School to the annual Rotary Youth Leadership camp held each summer at Keystone College. At RYLA those students gain an outstanding experience in leadership training. Participants say it's a life-changing week of discovery. At the elementary school level, Trail Rotary donates a dictionary each year to every 3rd grade student.
