## **STUDENT DRESS POLICY**

# Student Dress Policy

- All articles of student dress must be appropriately sized to the student and worn properly.
- Clothing must not be excessively loose or tight.
- Students may not add to, nor subtract from, the approved student dress policy.
- Student clothing must be maintained in good condition, without holes, rips, tears, or additions.
- All clothing must maintain modesty expectations. Bare midriff, shoulders, back, and chest are prohibited.
- Administration reserves the right to make judgments when necessary regarding appropriate dress to insure conformity and consistency.
- Students who violate the student dress policy will be subject to disciplinary consequence.

# PANTS

## Permitted...

- Solid color, clean, well-maintained
- Secured at the waist
- May wear jeans



## NOT Permitted...

- Cargo pants
- Excessively baggy or tight pants
- Fatigues, sweatpants, windpants, yoga pants



\* Students may wear sweatpants/windpants on gym days ONLY \*

# SKIRTS /SKORTS/DRESSES

## Permitted...

- Solid color or patterns, clean, well-maintained
- Ankle length to 2" above the knee
- Dresses do not need to have a collar



\*Skirts, skorts and dresses may be worn by female students ONLY\*

# SHORTS

## Permitted...

- Solid or patterns, clean, well-maintained
- Formal/Dress style or cargo
- Secured at the waist



## NOT Permitted...

- Gym shorts, spandex, jean shorts, fatigues or the like
- Shorter than 2" above the knee



\*Students may wear gym shorts on gym days only\*

# CAPRIS

## Permitted...

- Solid color, clean, well-maintained
- Formal/Dress style
- May include jeans
- Secured at the waist



\* Capris may be worn by female students ONLY\*

# SHIRTS

## Permitted...

- Collared, button-down, dress or golf-style
- Solids, stripes, plaids and patterns
- Must have sleeves (long or short)
- Lackawanna Trail or approved affiliated logos



## NOT Permitted...

- More than 2 buttons unbuttoned from the throat
- Manufacturer's logos larger than 3" x 3"
- Self-made, manufactured or constructed logos
- Bare or exposed midriffs, shoulders, backs, chest

\* T-shirt, long sleeve t-shirt or turtleneck may be worn underneath \*

\*Students may wear t-shirts (with no visible writing/pictures other than those defined in logo/spirit day) on gym days only \*

# SWEATERS

Permitted...

- Solid color or patterns, clean, well-maintained
- Crewneck, turtleneck, v-neck, cardigan sweater, or sweater vest



\* A shirt or turtleneck (in accordance with policy) may be worn underneath the sweater \*



# SWEATSHIRTS

## Permitted...

- Solid color or patterns, clean, well-maintained
- Crewneck sweatshirts



## NOT Permitted...

- Hooded sweatshirts
- Logos larger than 3" x 3"

\* A shirt or turtleneck may be worn underneath the sweatshirt \*

\* Zip up sweatshirts must be zipped unless there is a collared shirt beneath the zip up (that conforms to shirt guidelines) \*

# TURTLENECKS

Permitted...

- May be worn under a sweater or sweatshirt
- Turtleneck sweaters may be worn independently



# SHOES

## Permitted...

- Dress shoes or sneakers
- Socks must be worn if shoe is closed toe



## NOT Permitted...

- Flip-flops or other beach shoes
- Unsafe footwear
- Shoes with wheels



\* Tights or nylons may be worn ONLY by females students \*

# FORMAL CLOTHES

\* Students may wear clothes of a more formal nature \*



**Boys: Men's or boy's suits or sport coats with solid color pants, dress shoes, dress shirt and tie**

**Girls: Women's or girl's dresses or suits. A sweater or blazer can be added to formal attire to meet modesty expectations of policy. A blouse without a collar may be worn if it meets the modesty expectations.**



\* Formal clothes must conform with all other aspects of the dress policy\*



# OTHER



Permitted during school hours...

- Headbands

NOT Permitted during school hours...

- Sunglasses
- Scarves
- Jackets, coats, or other outerwear
- Head-coverings
- Bandanas



# LOGOS, WRITING, PICTURES

## Permitted...

- “Lackawanna Trail” or approved Trail affiliated logos
- Manufacturer’s logos no larger than 3” x 3”



## NOT Permitted...

- Printing, sayings, scenes or the like
- Self-made, manufactured or constructed logos

\* Students may wear gym clothes ONLY on days when they have physical education classes \*

# SPIRIT DAYS

## Permitted...

- Lackawanna Trail logos on all items of dress—not limited in size



## NOT Permitted...

- Other advertisements (i.e. local businesses)

\* Spirit Days will be designated and communicated by administration \*

# GYM DAYS

## Permitted...

- T-shirts, sweatshirts
- Gym shorts
- Sweatpants or windpants



## NOT Permitted...

- Writing on t-shirts, sweatpants or windpants other than logo as described in policy

\* Students may wear gym clothes ONLY on days when they have physical education classes \*
