AWARDS POLICY

A. Earned School Awards

I. Authority to Make Awards

- a. The coach or advisors shall recommend the members of their squads who have met the requirements for a letter. These recommendations are to be approved by the Athletic Director. If any problems arise, the coach or advisor, athletic director and secondary principal will confer and make a final decision.

II. Awards to be given

- b. Teams winning either League or District Championships will receive picture plaques for that achievement.

III. Award Requirements

a. Hockey, Basketball, Football

If you play in one-half of the quarters during the league season, you will receive 4 points, which is equivalent to a varsity letter.

b. Baseball and Softball

If you play in one-half of the innings during the league season, you will receive 4 points.

c. Pitchers

If you pitch in 2/10 of the innings during the league season, you will receive 4 points.

d. Volleyball, Golf, Wrestling

If you participate in ½ of the matches during the league season, you will receive 4 points.

e. Cross Country and Track and Field

If you participate in $\frac{1}{2}$ of the meets during the league season, you will receive 4 points.

f. All Sports

If you are a member of the squad in good standing, you will receive 2 points.

Members of junior varsity teams will receive 2 points.

g. Managers

For each sport, you will receive 2 points.

h. Awards of Cheerleaders

Varsity cheerleaders –4 points for each sport season completed in good standing.

Advisors will set up requirements that must be met by each cheerleader to be eligible for 4 points.

i. Awards for Marching Band

Varsity marching band – 4 points for each fall season completed in good standing.

The director(s) will set up requirements that must be met by each marching band member in grades 9-12 only to be eligible for 4 points.

B. Honorary Special Awards

I. Senior Athlete Award

- a. Outstanding senior boy athlete and outstanding senior girl athlete. The Athletic Director will prepare a list of all senior students eligible. They will be voted upon by all varsity coaches.
- b. Athletes will not be eligible for this award if they have left a team or have been dismissed from a team during the season.
- c. The Athletic Director will tabulate the results and will only vote in case of a tie.

II. Special Awards

These will be given from time to time by the Athletic Department to people who have made contributions to the Lackawanna Trail Athletic Program. These contributions will have been beyond participation in the Athletic Program.

Coaches can recommend people for this award and final consideration will be made by the Athletic Director and Secondary Principal.

III. Individual Awards

These are special awards presented to outstanding performers in each sport and cheerleading. Coaches and advisors will submit the awards they wish to present for approval by the Athletic Director and Secondary Principal.
