

The LTSD Board of Education met in their Regular board meeting on January 13 @ 7:35pm in the board room, public notice thereof having been given in accordance with applicable law. President Lombardi, called the meeting to order and had the Secretary call the roll. Motion by Mr. Clarke, Mr. Bianchi that the minutes from the November 11, 2013 general meeting, the December 2, 2013 Reorganization meeting, the December 2, 2013 Special meeting and the December 12, 2013 Special meeting be approved as submitted. Passed 8-1, Mr. Strauch voting "NO" **since details required by the various laws were not included and there were numerous errors.**

Motion by Dr. Mould, Mr. Strauch that the Treasurer's report be approved as submitted.

Motion by Dr. Mould, Mr. Bianchi that all bills found to be true and accurate be approved.

Motion by Mrs. Selwood, Mr. Strauch that a resolution pursuant to Act 1 of 2001 indicating that the Lackawanna Trail School District will not raise the rate of tax support of its public schools for the 2014-2015 fiscal year by more than the index established by the Department of Education for the district of 2.8% be approved.

Motion by Mr. Thorne, Mr. Bianchi that the 2012-2013 Single Audit prepared by Murphy, Dougherty be approved as submitted.
