To this end, the curriculum shall be evaluated, adapted and developed on a continuing basis and in accordance with a plan for curriculum growth.</p> <p>2. Definition For purposes of this policy, curriculum shall be defined as all planned learning activities of the schools such as:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">the courses of study, subjects, classes, and organized group activities provided by the school.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">formal classroom instruction and out-of-class activity, both individual and group.</p> <p>3. Authority The Board is responsible for the curriculum of the schools. 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4. Delegation of Responsibility

provide all pupils continuous access to sufficient programs and services of a library/media facility, classroom collection, or both, to support the educational program

provide all pupils guidance and counseling to assist in career and academic planning

provide a continuum of educational programs and services for all handicapped children, pursuant to law and regulation

provide all pupils equal educational opportunity, pursuant to law and regulation

As educational leader of the district, the Superintendent shall be responsible to the Board for the development of curriculum, and shall establish procedures for curriculum development, which ensure effective participation of teaching staff members, members of the Board and the utilization of all available resources, as appropriate.

The Board directs the Superintendent to pursue actively State and federal aid in support of curriculum development.
