	206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT		1
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1. Purpose	The Board directs that the assignment of students to schools within this district be consistent with proper education of students and the best use of the resources of this district.	SC 1310	4
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2. Authority	The Board shall determine periodically the school attendance areas of the district and shall expect the students within each district to attend the school so designated. In assigning pupils to schools within this district, no distinction whatever shall be made on the basis of the student's race or color.	SC 1310	10
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3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent shall periodically review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by: considerations of safe student transportation and travel, convenience of access to schools, financial and administrative efficiency, the effectiveness of the instructional program or class size.		18
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Pupils may be transferred by the principal and/or Superintendent, from one room or building to another whenever necessary by reason of of promotion, overcrowding, change of residence, or for such other reasons as the Superintendent of Schools may deem desirable. Transfers will be made on a space available basis.

Whenever feasible, the Superintendent and the principal will not transfer students from one building to a second unless all members of the family attending the first building are transferred to the second building if the parents desire. Furthermore, every effort will be made to ensure that a student is not transferred more than once during the elementary years, when an appropriate class assignment is available in the second building. However, this last statement is voided if a child's residence changes.

Students reassigned upon parents' request and with the Superintendent's approval, shall abrogate all rights to free school transportation. Transportation to and from the reassigned school becomes the responsibility of the parent.

The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs of the student as well as the administration of the school.
