	<p style="text-align: center;">612. PURCHASES NOT BUDGETED</p> <p>1. Purpose The laws of the State and the interests of the community require fiscal responsibility by the Board in the operation of the school district. Appropriate fiscal controls are hereby adopted to insure that public funds are not disbursed in amounts in excess of the appropriations provided this district.</p> <p>2. Authority When funds are not available for a proposed appropriation, a legal transfer from one class of expenditure to another may be made in the last nine months of the fiscal year by the Board if it is apparent that the necessary surplus funds do exist in another appropriation and if the procedures specified in the School Code are followed.</p> <p>3.
