702. GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS

1. Purpose

The Board recognizes that individuals and organizations in the community may wish to contribute additional supplies or equipment to enhance or extend the instructional program.

2. Authority

The Board will exercise its authority to accept such gifts and donations as may be made to the district or to any school in the district by resolution duly passed at a public meeting except that the Superintendent may accept on behalf of the Board any such gift less than \$8,000 in value.

The Board reserves the right to refuse to accept any gift which does not contribute toward the achievement of the goals of this district or the ownership of which would tend to adversely affect the district.

Any gift accepted by the Board, or its designee, shall become the property of the district, may not be returned without the approval of the Board, and is subject to the same controls and regulations as are other properties of the district.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall:

counsel potential donors on the appropriateness of gifts

encourage individuals and organizations considering a contribution to the schools to consult with the principal or Superintendent before appropriating funds to that end
