SOS. CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEES

▪ Purpose

Citizen advisory committees are sometimes useful in keeping the Board and administration informed with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school problems.

▪ Regulations

In creating a new advisory committee, the Board shall define the committee assignment and shall:

appoint members who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function.

seek the widest range of community interest and backgrounds.

approve the appointment of citizens by the Superintendent.

appoint the President and the Superintendent as ex officio members of all advisory committees.

In charging a new advisory committee, the Board shall set a date for a preliminary and final report.

Recommendations of all advisory committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Board which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations as it sees fit. Meetings of an advisory committee shall not be open to the public upon the invitation of the committee only.
