MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT RELATIONS</p> <p>Purpose It is the policy of the Board that this Board, school officials, and municipal officials maintain a close requisite for dealing with school/community matters and problems in the most satisfactory manner and assuring the most prudent expenditure of tax dollars.</p> <p>Authority The Board recognizes that its authority arises directly from the General Assembly, but it also is aware that the municipality and the school district must work together for the welfare of the citizens.</p> <p>Responsibility The Board advocates the joint expenditure of district funds and municipal or county funds to provide those facilities from which the entire community, children and adults alike, may derive benefits.
