916. VI:Alma

The purpose of the school volunteer coaching program is to encourage community involvement in student extracurricular activities and goals by enhancing the extracurricular programs provided to the districts students through the efforts of community volunteers.

Towards this end, the Board shall require any and all volunteer coaching applicants to meet the following requirements:

1. Shall submit a letter of application and resume.
2. Shall have necessary clearances on file. [Act 34 State Police and Act 151 Child Abuse]
3. Shall be twenty-one (21) years of age.
4. Shall have played or have experience in the sport.
5. Shall be familiar with Lackawanna Trail School District and P1AA rules and regulations.
6. Shall have the ability to *meet* the time commitments of games and practices.
7. Shall be interviewed by the Principal, Athletic Director, and Plead Coach. If a unanimous written agreement is not reached, the superintendent will review the information and will decide if the candidate should be recommended to the school board.
8. Shall be recommended, in writing, by the principal to the Superintendent for review and recommendation to the Board of Education.
9. Shall be approved by the Board of Education
10. Shall understand and agree that no compensation shall be paid.

Other qualifications may be made by the Board of Education or administration as necessary.

Information submitted to the Superintendent and the School Board shall remain confidential.

The superintendent and Board of Education may terminate any volunteer coach and/or volunteer coaching position at their discretion.
