

STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR USING THIS HOMEWORK CHECKLIST

- 1. You must record your homework in the proper space when it is assigned. Remember – homework does not have to be a written assignment! For Example “Read pages 35-42” or “study for chapter 5 quiz”. If no homework is assigned simply write “none” in the space for that subject.**
- 2. At the end of class, ask your teacher to initial your checklist to confirm that you have written the correct assignments.**
- 3. Refer to your checklist at the end of the day so that you know which books to take home.**
- 4. Complete all assigned work and show your parents**

Parent Guidelines

- 1. Each night check your child’s completed homework.**
- 2. Set a goal (for example, all homework done for one week). If your child reaches that goal, reward him or her with a special privilege. (Movie, sleep over at friend’s house, etc)**
- 3. If your child does not complete his or her work, take away a privilege (Television, use of phone, grounded). It is important to be consistent. Do not accept excuses such as “I left it in my locker” or “I forgot to get it signed”. If they are punished their memory will improve.**
- 4. If your child completes his/her homework in study hall, he/she must bring it home for you to check.**
